
From thousands of tragic events,


Drawing Hope with Elaan in India

In India, there are few support services for survivors of rape and sexual abuse. In India, there is no effective law prohibiting sexual abuse of children.

In 2012, Drawing Hope is collaborating with Elaan – a Kolkata-based, all-volunteer NGO that was founded by one of our members, Pranaadhika, and has been working for the last decade to transform survivor-support in India.

Together we will:

- Support Elaan’s initiative to educate a million people about rape, sexual abuse and human rights.
- Support Elaan’s campaign for legislative change in India.


